

Safety data sheets (SDS):

Safety data sheets are automatically updated on a daily basis. The users receive emails informing them about changes to safety data sheets. In isi!! Hazard Substance Management, such changes are indicated by a special symbol next to the product.

Risk assessment / Protective measures:

Work-related assessments can be made with the help of prepared checklists. We also offer hand, eye, ear and breathing protection which can be used along side hazardous substances.

Operating instructions:

Editable operating instruction templates for Würth chemical products are available. The operating instructions detail the proper handling of the hazardous substances used as well as specify required protective measures and modes of behaviour.

Briefings:

isi!! Hazardous Substance Management offers the opportunity to manage briefing measures for employees and to guarantee the regular briefing of employees thanks to automatic reminders. Furthermore, we provide an editable template of a briefing confirmation.

Hazardous substance inventory:

Hazardous substance inventories relating to specific work areas are drawn up automatically and can be managed online. The hazardous substance inventory aims at providing an overview of the hazardous substances produced or used at the company.

The following information is included:

- Description and article number of the hazardous material
- Labelling (hazardous substances pictograms, H statements, P statements, water hazard class and storage class)
- Quantity data
- Description of work areas where employees may come into contact with hazardous substances


Storage of hazardous substances:



COSHH/Risk stands for The Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations.

Almost all organisations will buy, use or produce hazardous substances, from cleaning solutions to highly toxic chemicals, so everyone should know about the implications of COSHH at work.



RISK ASSESSMENT COMPLETED IN 8 STEPS!



Importance.

Every year, thousands of workers become ill by hazardous substances, contracting lung diseases such as asthma, cancer and skin diseases, such as dermatitis.

Most businesses use substances, whether they are mixtures of substances or use processes that create them. These could harm employees, contractors and other people. Substances such as cement, plaster, adhesives, solvents, paints and fuels all pose a risk.

Regulations.

COSHH/Risk places duties on employers and employees. They set out a step by step approach for protecting people exposed to them.

COSHH does not cover:

- Lead
- Asbestos
- Radioactive substances

These have their own specific regulations.



Breach of COSHH/Risk regulations by an employer or employee is a crime, punishable by an unlimited fine!

What are the COSHH/Risk symbols and their meanings?

The CLP hazard pictograms alert us to the presence of a hazardous chemical. The pictograms help us to know that the chemicals we are using might cause harm to people or the environment. One or more pictograms might appear on the labelling of a single chemical.



HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES EXPLAINED



Explosive

Self-reactive substances & organic peroxides that may cause an explosion when heated



Flammable

Substances that may catch fire when in contact with air, heat or water that emit flammable gases



Oxidising

Gases, solids & liquids, which can cause or intensify fire and an explosion



Gases Under Pressure

Gas under pressure, may explode when heated, refridgerated gas, may cause cryogenic burns or injuries, or, dissolved gases



Corrosive

Corrosive & can cause severe skin burns and eye damage. It is also corrosive to metals



Toxic

Handling a chemical that is acutely toxic in contact with skin if inhaled or ingested, may be fatal



Caution

Acutely toxic, causes skin sensitisation, skin & eye irritation, respiratory irritant narcotic (causes drowsiness or dizziness), or hazardous to the ozone layer




Long Term Health Hazards

One or more of the following: Carcinogenic, affects fertility & unborn children, causes mutations, respiratory sensitiser, which may cause allergy, asthma or breathing difficulties when inhaled, toxic to specific organs, or may be fatal or harmful if swallowed or if it enters airways



Dangerous for the Environment

Hazardous to the environment & causes aquatic toxicity

MSDS vs COSHH/Risk, what's the difference?

MSDS and COSHH/Risk whilst linked, they are NOT the same thing; here's why:

MSDS follows a 16 section format which is internationally agreed and they alone do not constitute a Risk Assessment; they are key documents in the safe supply, handling and use of chemicals. The MSDS has information which is used to help complete the COSHH Risk Assessment.

So in short, MSDS gives you information about the substance itself whereas COSHH/Risk assessment is about the substance in the actual work activity / application.

We have the Safety Data Sheets for all of our hazardous substances; do we still need to carry out COSHH/Risk assessments?

YES. A good safety data sheet (SDS) does not substitute for carrying out and recording a COSHH risk assessment.

What does it cost to use ISI?

Nothing at all, you only need a login to your online account.

Can I adjust the documents?

Yes, you can provide the work instructions card and the dangerous goods register with a name of the safety manager, emergency number, company name and logo.

Are all documents up-to-date?

You will always see the most recent version online. We recommend that you download or download the documents to print. You will receive a reminder from us if a document changes or when you purchase a product for the first time.

Which file formats can I choose?

The safety data sheets and work instruction cards are supplied as standard in PDF. The hazardous substances register can also be downloaded as CSV / Excel.

Can I also add products from another brand?

Yes, you can add all your products, so you have 1 overview

What training / qualifications should I have to carry out COSHH/Risk assessments?

You don't need any particular qualifications but you must have the necessary knowledge, skills and experience to do the job properly.
